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## About the Comprehensive Executive Function Inventory Adult™

In combination with other information, results from the CEFI Adult help calibrate an individual's level of executive function in the following areas: Attention, Emotion Regulation, Flexibility, Inhibitory Control, Initiation, Organization, Planning, Self-Monitoring, and Working Memory.

To help the user interpret inter-rater differences in reported executive function behaviors and to provide an overview of the individual's behavior from a multi-rater perspective, this computerized report combines the results from up to three raters. 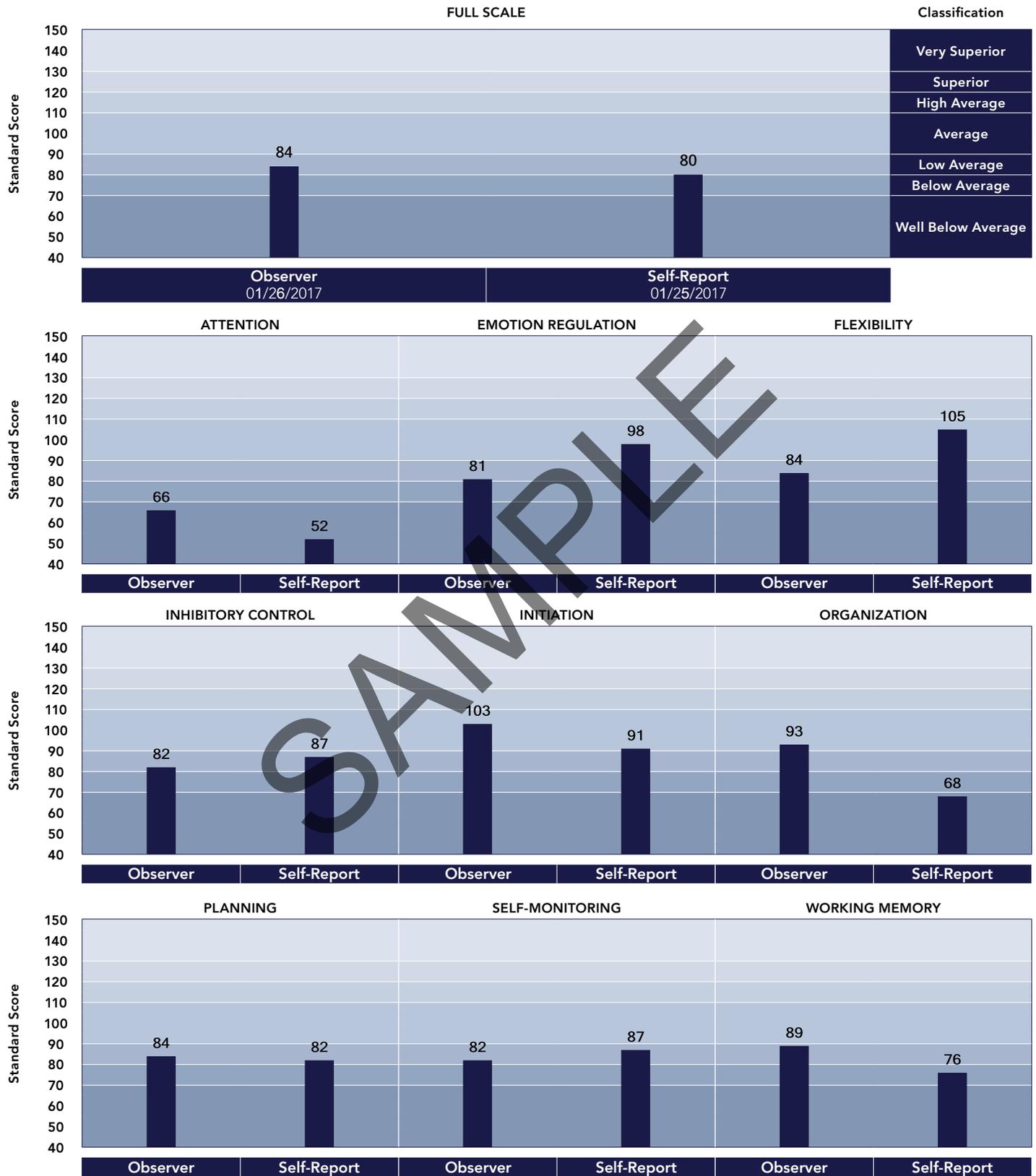
## About the Ratings
